Do not be alarmed at the 2 snakes that have been put on some greens, but do exercise caution as you approach them, there may be a real snake there. The rubber ones are an experiment to see if we can deter the cockies from eating the greens, especially around the rim of the hole.

The Committee asks that no-one take either their cart or their buggy onto any tee or green.

Please repair ALL Divots and Pitch Marks – even if they are not yours. Keep an eye out as you walk up the fairways and on the greens for any repairs needed.

A big 'Shout Out' to all the volunteers who are working steadily on keeping the course in such great condition. Your help repairing divots and pitch mark makes their lives that little bit easier.

UPCOMING EVENTS

A very full Program of Golf events awaits us for February/March:

The first Saturday of February, the 6th, is, as always, Monthly Medal.

Saturday 13 February will be a round of Vegas Style Stableford. This involves teams of 4 players in which Teams of two players are chosen and a team score is calculated on each hole by putting the lowest stableford score first e.g. player 1 scores 3 points for the hole and player 2 scores 2 points – the team score is 23. The golfers' scores for each hole are paired up for a combined score.

Saturday 20 February is the day for the Honour Board Event, the Red Tees Plate.



Saturday 6 March will be Monthly Medal day followed on the Monday with a Stableford event to celebrate the Labour Day Long-weekend.

The next Saturday, 13 March, will be a 4 person Ambrose – grab 3 partners and join us for this.

A 2 Ball Ambrose will be played on the Back Nine on the Wednesday 17th.

The last 2 Saturdays of March, the 20th and 27th, will host the playing of the 1st and 2nd Rounds of both the Club Championships AND the Kiewa Cup. The Club Championships will be played over 5 weekends with the best 3 of your rounds counting for the final score. The Kiewa Cup is the aggregate score of your 2 rounds over the 2 weekends.

PAST EVENTS



On Saturday 16 January the Herb Gilbert Memorial Trophy event was played out. The event is a 4BBB comp with the eventual pair coming out on top was Peter Dilley and Tony Campen with a net 46 points followed closely by Don Mason and Alan Retallick (45) and Ben Charlton and Taff Sullivan with 44 points.

The eventual winner was a regular red tee player in Peter Partington, with a creditable 23 points, on a countback from Darren 'Rattles' Flay. Peter Dilley and Peter Johns were handed balls for there 21 point efforts.

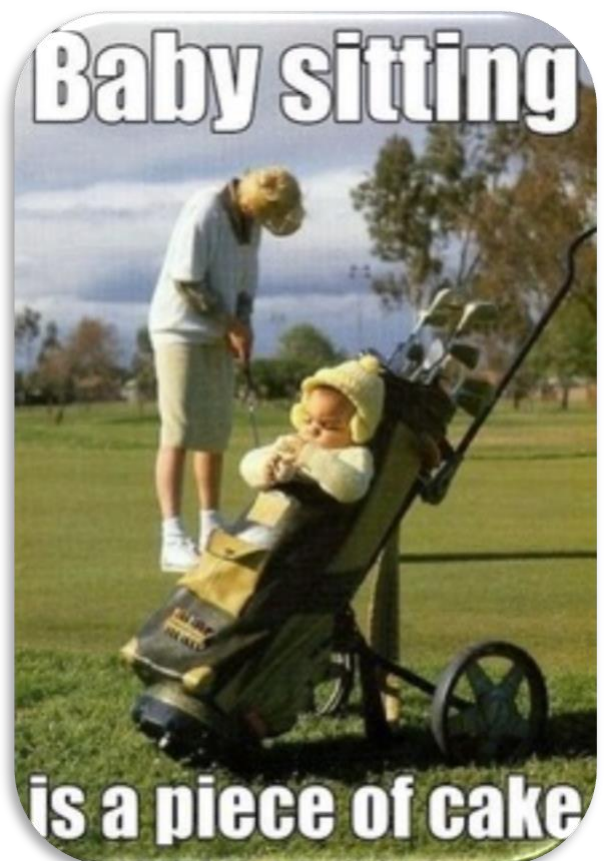
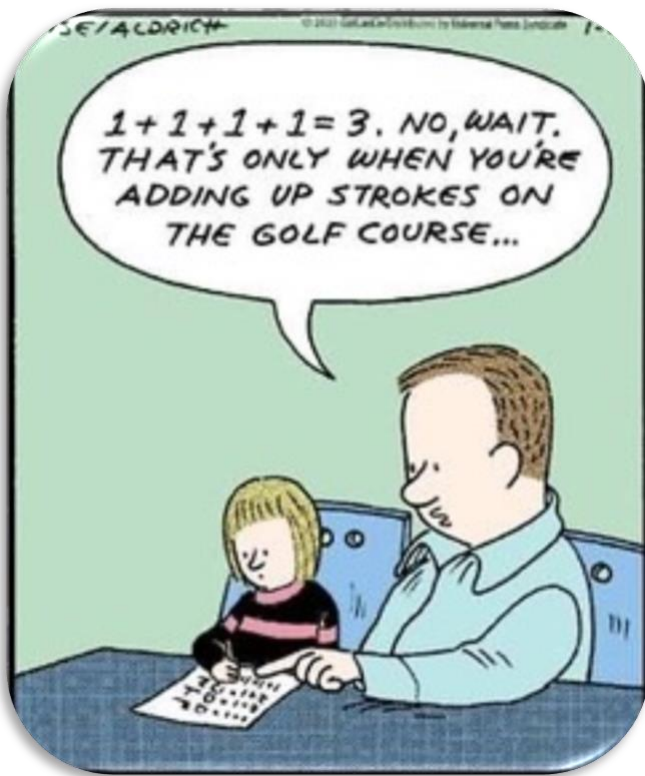
