COMMITTEE NEWS

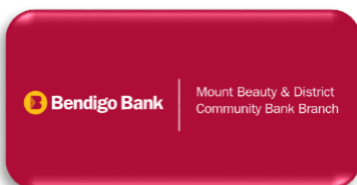
The Committee wishes all members, reciprocal club members, sponsors and all their families and friends a Very Happy New Year for 2021.

Please repair ALL Divots and Pitch Marks – even if they are not yours. Keep an eye out as you walk up the fairways and on the greens for any repairs needed.

A big 'Shout Out' to all the volunteers who are working steadily on keeping the course in such great condition. Your help repairing divots and pitch mark makes their lives that little bit easier.

Toward the end of the month there will be a Red Tees event for the Back Nine holes on Wednesday 20 January, followed on the Saturday by a 4BBB Stableford event.

On the Tuesday, 26 January, we will play an Australia Day Stableford round.

The first Saturday of February, the 6th, is, as always, Monthly Medal.

Saturday 13 February will be a round of Vegas Style Stableford. This involves teams of 4 players in which Teams of two players are chosen and a team score is calculated on each hole by putting the lowest stableford score first e.g. player 1 scores 3 points for the hole and player 2 scores 2 points – the team score is 23. The golfers' scores for each hole are paired up for a combined score.

Saturday 20 February is the day for the Honour Board Event, the Red Tees Plate.

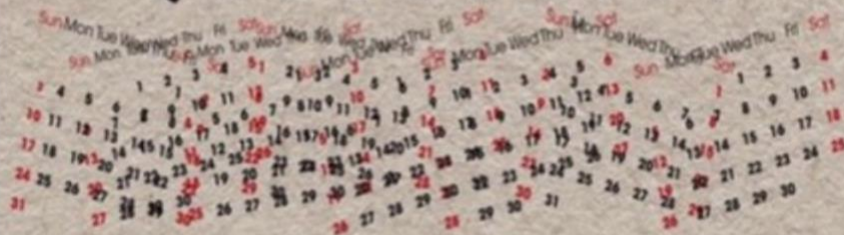
