LAUGH TIME

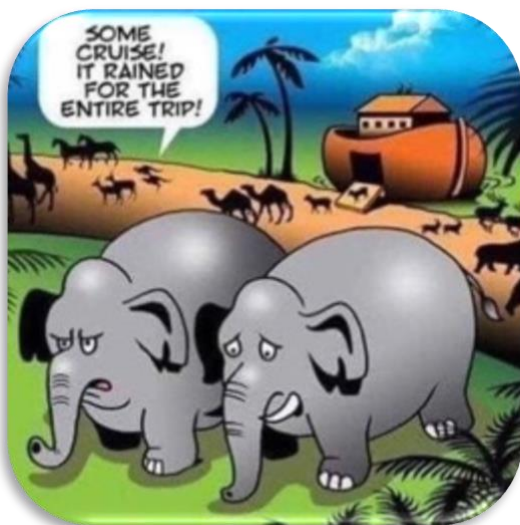
