#### Course News

Plans are well under way and quotes are being sort for the removal and disposal of up to 50 dead and dying pines from the course. This will possibly happen over the next few weeks and may cause some unavoidable damage to some fairways. Apologies in advance, but rest assured all precautions will be taken to avoid major damage. Please be patient and understanding - it will only take a short time for the damage to disappear.

A reminder to cart drivers to please use common sense and stay at least 10m away from any greens. Your cooperation is very much appreciated.

It is asked that NO carts be driven to the left side of the 17th green to enable ground staff to get the grass established in that area.

Attendance at the Saturday 9 Hole Comp has waned as of late and I would like to remind you all that everyone is welcome to play the 9 hole event with the regulars. This is a great event to play if you have not got the time to devote all afternoon to golf, for whatever reason. Start time is the same as the 18 hole event - noon for 12.30pm on the Saturdays.

Cam and the regular volunteers have been kept busy mowing and maintaining the course. The new fairway mower has proved its worth as the fairways are looking, and playing, the best I can remember them. Rarely a bad lie is taken and the contours of the fairways adds to the character of the course.

If anyone has a spare hour or so and looking for something to do - there is always sticks to be collected under the trees on all fairways. With the increasing numbers of kangaroos on the course if your ball happens to go near them it is safer to take relief and drop another ball, no closer to the hole, rather than try to retrieve your ball from within the mob.

On the weekend of 9, 10 and 11 October 6 representatives journeyed to Belvoir Park GC, Bendigo, to compete in the Victorian Men's Country Teams Championships. Numbers were down a little with only 34 teams represented this year.



We were allowed 2 teams and naturally some rivalry and some friendly, most of the time, sledging occurred.

Results were OK with Team 2, Dave Browning, Tony Campen and Webby doing slightly better overall than Team 1, Trev English, Emil Solar and Michael Bartholomew. Good company, great apres golfing and a course in great condition made the weekend very enjoyable for all. The navigator for Team 1 fell asleep at a crucial time on the trip home giving us the opportunity to explore regions up near Rochester. I did tell Trev to look out for signs to Murchison or Rushworth!

This was our third outing to these Champiohships and Mt Beauty GC is priviliged to have been asked to host the event for 2016. The Committee is busy planning for this event.

The most important rounds for the Men in October were the Club Championships held over consecutive Saturdays beginning on 3 October. The 3 best scores over the 5 rounds counted toward a persons Championship Score, both Stroke and Handicap.

I must say it was a most exciting and interesting way to conduct this important event as placings were really not too clear until after the final round. Some could not play in the last round and others had to score well, having had only 3 rounds available for them to compete. The A grade result required some very good scores to catch the eventual winner. The B Grade winner was always in the lead and played extremely well over the month, include non-championship rounds. C Grade was hotly contested with the

result reflecting how well the eventual winner played, having had a round of 87 off the stick somewhere in the middle of his 4 rounds.

Club Champion: Mick Luscombe (6) with a 239. Congratulations to Mick on his well deserved win, 9 strokes ahead of rival Alan Retallick.

A Grade Champion: Mick Luscome followed by Alan Retallick (9) with 248 and Alan Ferrari (11) with a close 250

B Grade Champion: Don Mason (13) with a creditable 260 followed by President Stephen (13) with 264, closely pursued by Darren Flay (17) with 266

54 Hole Handicap Champion: Their scores were 215 and the result was decided by a playoff between Darren Flay and Rollo Kiek on Saturday 7 November. Both teed off the 18th with Darren just missing out on playing from the sand whilst Rollo,

rather nervously, put his in the gully well before the green. A rather untidy chip shot propelled the ball off the toe of the club, with Rollo's third shot hitting the green.



Meanwhile Darren had chipped his ball to within 4 metres of the hole. It took both men 2 putts to finish the hole and resulted in Darren winning the Championship.

#### **Junior Golf Clinic**

The Mt Beauty Golf Club is running a series of 10 free golf lessons for girls and boys aged 6-14 years old, with members coaching.

The junior golf clinics are well underway with 24 participants. The group is divided into 4 and they all do 4 different golf activities each day after some stretching and physical activity. The group ranges from prep grade to year 8 at secondary school.

We have plenty of equipment which has been purchased with funding from the Bendigo Bank, VicHealth and Golf Victoria. The Club also purchased junior irons which participants can hire long term so they have something to practice with at home. The improvement shown in the few weeks is great. The older students, who participated last year, are ready to play a few holes with club members showing them the ropes.

While the junior lessons are underway, there is coaching for parents. Hopefully this will encourage a few more players among the adults. There is also a group of more experienced players who are new to Mt Beauty or who have not played golf for many years. Another of our members has been showing them around the course.

The gauntlet has been thrown down by the 'twilighters' at Wednesday Comp. They reckon they are the better players!!


Captain Peter Hertzog outlines the 'rules' below:
