COURSE NEWS



Allan Retallick has been very busy of late re-painting all of our tee marker signs by hand. He obtained some solvent/adhesive from Peter Dilley and wiped them clean before re-painting.



As always at this time of the year the course is getting softer and wetter. Please be very mindful of any wet patches on the course when driving a motorised cart around.

NO CARTS are to be bought closer than 10 metres from ANY green and please use common sense when negotiating any of the course and avoid driving through the wetter areas. Any damage caused takes a long time to 'heal' and causes ruts on the course which harden over spring and summer making for extra work by the grounds volunteers.

The Committee and the volunteers thank you for your consideration.



Please be aware that all wildlife on the course can be dangerous if approached.

With the increasing numbers of kangaroos on the course, if your ball happens to go near them, it would be safer to take relief and drop another ball no closer to the hole, rather than try to retrieve your ball from within their mob.

Please do not attempt to feed or chase any of the kangaroos & please do not allow your dogs to chase them either.

A big 'Shout Out' to all the volunteers who are working steadily on keeping the course in such great condition. Not to be forgotten are the Ladies who clean our clubhouse for us weekly. Please repair ALL Divots and Pitch Marks – even if they are not yours. Keep an eye out as you walk up the fairways and on the greens for any repairs needed.






