COURSE NEWS

NO CARTS are to be driven closer than 10 metres to ANY green.

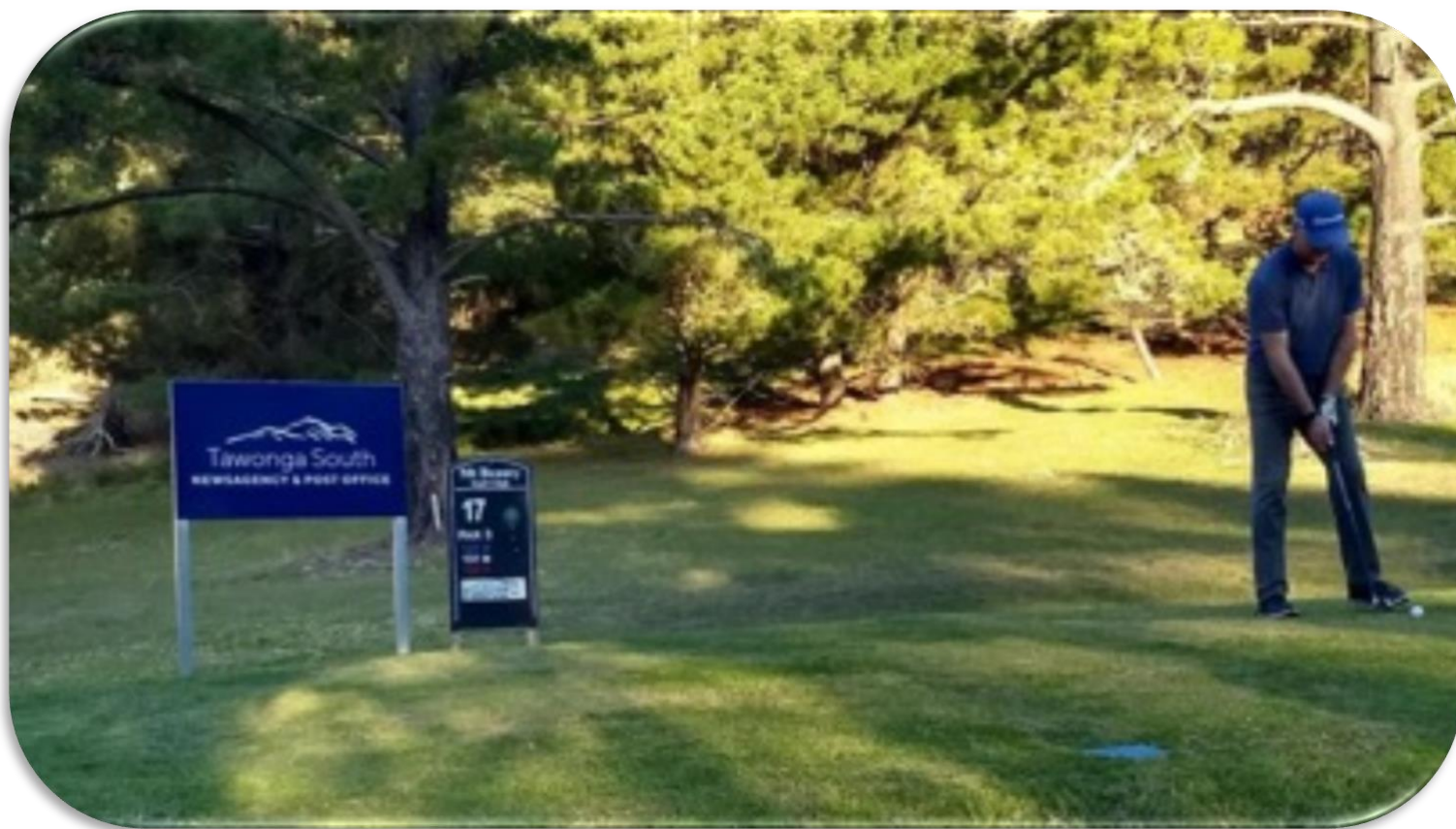
