NTP's on the 7th was Keith Archibald along with the Tatts Ticket from the Tawonga South Newsagency & PO, 9th went to Dave Browning, 17th to Macca Deans. The

money for the 18th went to Ross Rynehart.





Saturday 10 May was a very important day in the Mount Beauty Golf Club calendar. The Steve Green Memorial 4BBB was fought out with Peter Hertzog & Anthony Boschetti proving victorious with 42 points. Stuie Jelbart & Mark Redmond were second on a count back from Allan Retallick & Ross Rynehart with their 38 points apiece. NTP's went to Stuie Jelbart on the 7th along with the Tatts Ticket from the Tawonga South Newsagency & Post Office. The 9th went to Macca Deans, 17th to Roger Church. The money on the 18th was collected by Ross Rynehart.

It was Steve Green who instigated the changing of our course from sand scrapes to the present-day greens in 1998. The conversion took 2 years to achieve & today is ably attended by a group of volunteers under the direction of Stephen Short. An important day for the Golf Club.

The better individual scores on the day were Peter Hertzog with 31 points with Stuie Jelbart, Anthony Boschetti & Stephen Short with 30 points apiece.



Monday 12 June was our King's Birthday 2 Ball Ambrose event. This year it was decided to have a draw for playing partners. With the field divided equally in half, by handicap, a draw was made from the low handicap heap then the high handicap heap. This proved to be a much fairer way of sorting pairs as was seen in the closeness of the scoring. The winning pair consisted of Victor Selway & Michael Bartholomew (pictured) with 66.75 points. Second place went to Dave Etherton & Dave Browning with 67 points. 3rd place was shared by Fred Gerardson & Allan Retallick and Ross Rynehart & Liz Harvey with their 67.75 apiece. NTP's went to Stuie Jelbart on the 7th, along with the Tatts Ticket from the Tawonga South Newsagency & Post Office, 9th was Rick Biesboer while Allan Retallick proved superior

on both the 17th & 18th, taking home the money.

Saturday 24 June only 8 men rolled out on a cold day for the 2 Ball Multiplier comp. Mastering the cold was the father & son team of Rick & Gerad Biesboer their score of 61 points fending off Allan Retallick & Roger Church on 56 points.

NEDGA now has a website @ nedga.org.au which has all the information needed to find out what is happening in golf in our district. The fixtures for 2023 have been loaded to this website.

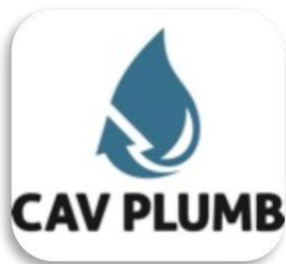

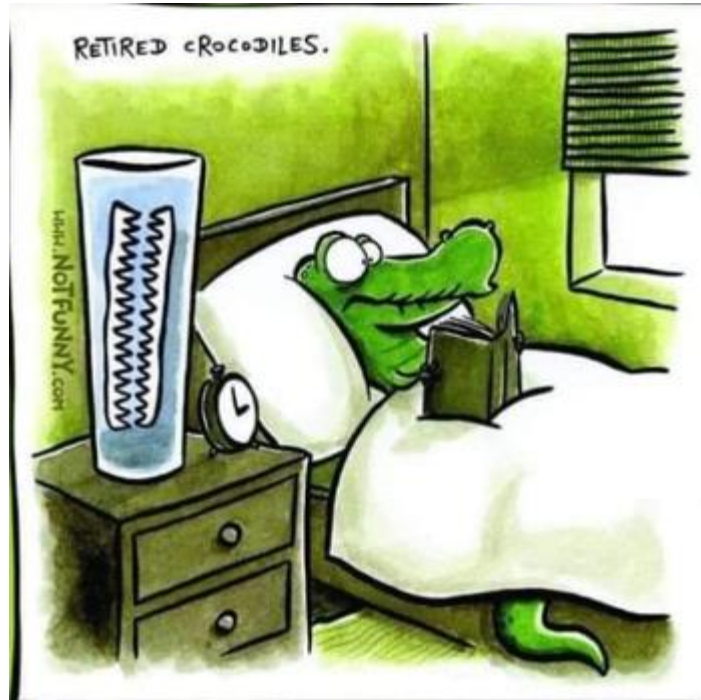

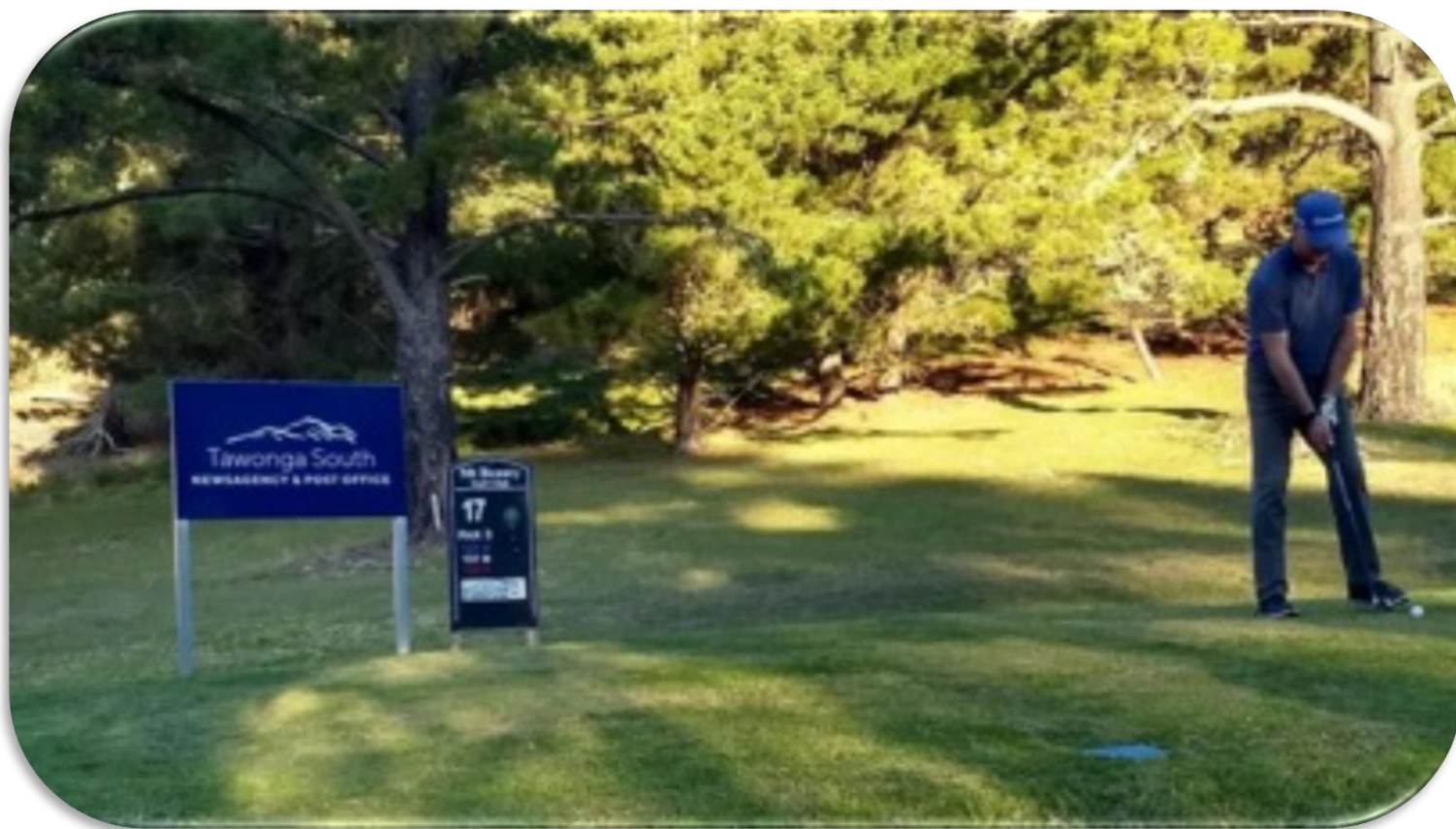
