## COURSE NEWS

New Sand Boxes have been placed at all tees with sand buckets. All members are encouraged to use them. A 'Fairway-of-the-Week' sign will be rotated to a new fairway weekly / fortnightly from now on & members are encouraged to fill their sand buckets & repair any divots on the fairway nominated, & all fairways for that matter, & any pitch marks on all greens.

The Grounds Volunteers have noticed considerable damage to some greens in the past few weeks. The damage is NOT animal in nature. It looks more like player/club-wielding damage. Misbehaviour of any sort will not be tolerated on the course & will attract privilege restrictions if witnessed by 'staff'.



Pipes have been laid down the 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & part of the 14<sup>th</sup> Fairways in anticipation of Fairway sprinkler installations & to improve the water pressure at the lower end of the course.

Sprinklers have already been installed in front of the 13<sup>th</sup> green where the ground is always hard due to the rocky nature of the top soil in the area. We hope to encourage the lush growth of grass at the site.

We thank Wes Dowel, Ridgeline Landscapes, for his



generous donation of the use of his Trench Digger & his time over a couple of days. It would have taken considerably longer & caused more disruption without his help.

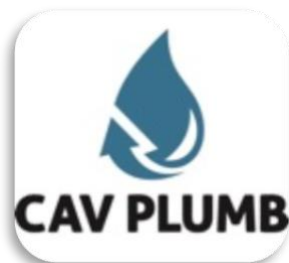

## EAGLES NEST RAIDED



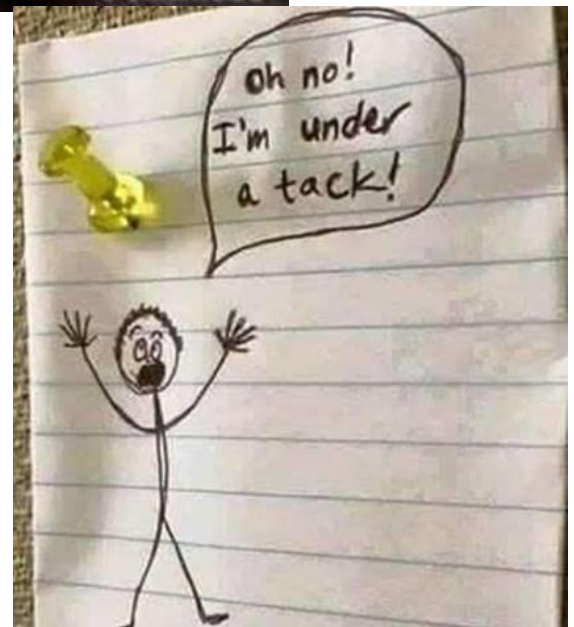

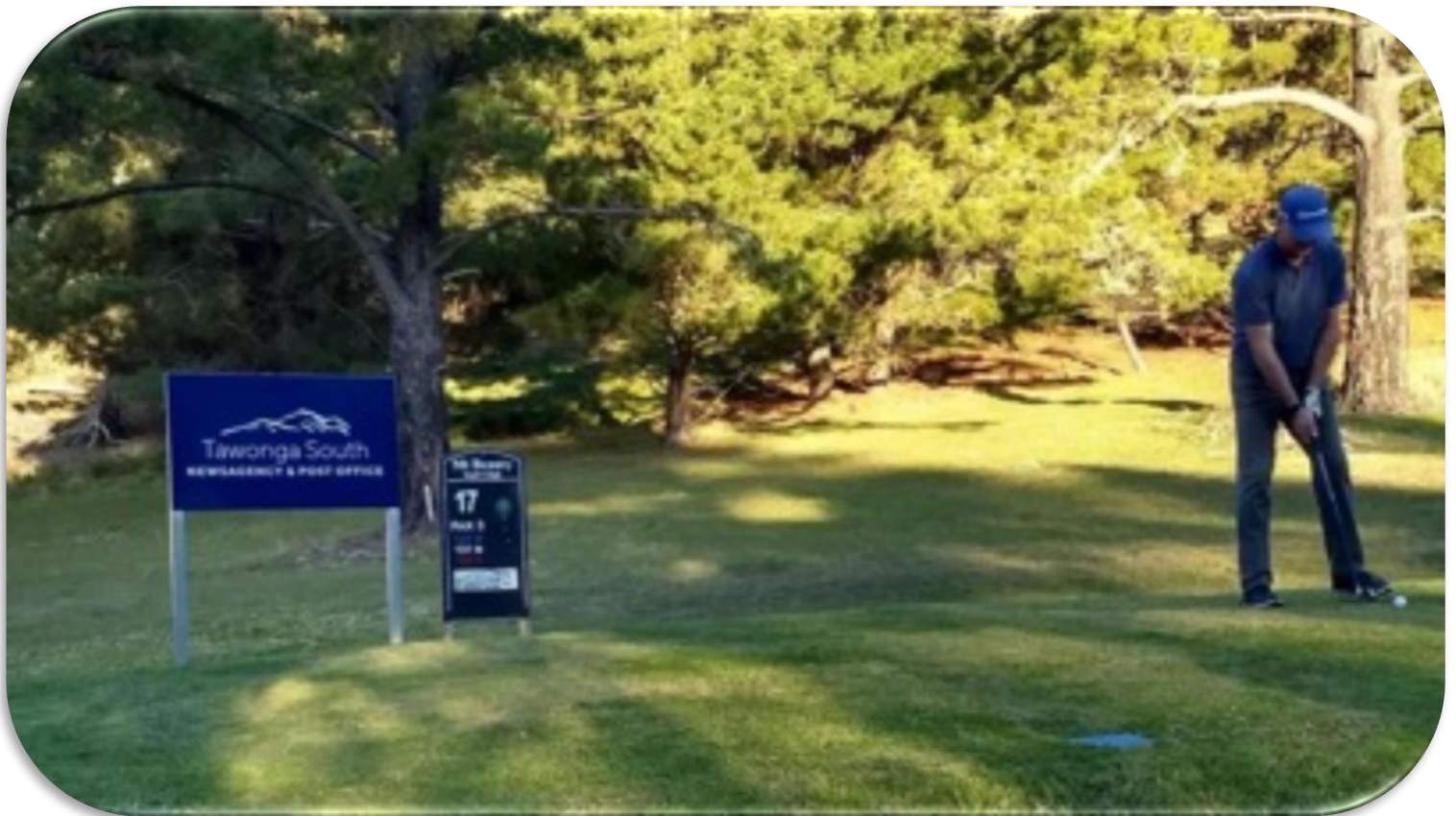
