UPCOMING EVENTS

Wednesday 3 April will be the last of the Twighlight 9 Hole Rounds for this summer. (Daylight Saving ends on Saturday 6 April).

The 1st Round of the Kiewa Hydro Cup has been postponed to Saturday 6 April due to the inclement weather on Saturday 30 March, and will be combined with the Monthly Medal competition. (The editor notes that 8 of us played on that Saturday in the weather and believe that only the 8 participants should be eligible for the Kiewa Cup!!) I bet that won't happen.

The 2nd Round will be played on the following Saturday, 13 April.

Saturday, 20 April, is Easter Saturday. The scheduled Jarman Cup Round has been postponed and the format of the day's comp will be determined on the day depending on participation numbers. There will be an Easter Monday 18 hole Stableford Mixed, Men's and Ladies' event.

Round 1 took the Pennant team to Myrtleford on Sunday 17 March where we were scheduled to meet Chiltern. Hard-fought games were played by all 5 members, 2 going down to the 18th and 19th holes. Winners were Stephen Short and Ben Peacock with Chiltern taking the honours with a 3/2 win. Myrtleford had a 5/0 win over Corowa and Tarrawingee defeated Jubilee 3/2.

Thankfully the weather held off for us and the day ended up a success with a win for Mount Beauty 4/1 over Jubilee, with only Trev not quite on his game that day. Myrtleford had another win and Corowa posted its first win. Our win put us in second place on the ladder behind Myrtleford. 
