Rules explained

One of the controversial parts of the Rules of golf is the concept of 'Nearest Point of Relief'.

I have taken an excerpt from the excellent book 'Do I Get a Drop?'

by Doug Anderson which I hope will clarify where the legal nearest point of relief lies.

Finding Nearest Point Of Relief



As the ball in this example is nearer to the right of the path, most players would drop on the right side of the path.

They would be wrong! The ball needs to be moved less to point A than to point B. Point A is the nearest point of relief.

How should this position be determined?

1. Take the stance, direction of play and the club that would have been used, if the problem area had not existed.

2. Swing the club, and determine the nearest point, from where a ball could be struck without interference to swing or stance by the problem area. That point must not be nearer the hole nor on a putting green or in a hazard...except when taking relief in a hazard.

3. The point where the ball would lie in that swing, is the "nearest point of relief", and the one club length measurement can be measured from that point with any club; usually the driver. It should be noted that we are not seeking the nearest point where an unrestricted stroke can be made... only the point where the problem area does not interfere. That point may be in the middle of a bush or tree from which the 1 club length may still leave the

player with little or no swing.
