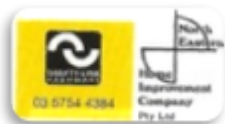

Gene Sarazen's Double Eagle (Albatross) at the 1935 Masters became known as 'The shot heard around the world' and led to a bridge at the Augusta course being named after him.

Because of an argument over what form the game should take, golf was dropped from the 1908 London Olympics.

In the 'Monkey Tournament' organized by the Atlanta Women's Golf Association in 1927, the club to be used for each shot was decided by drawing lots.
