Peter now joins the elite group of four heading to NZ where we will be playing for the NACZA (sic) Cup! More in a future newsletter.

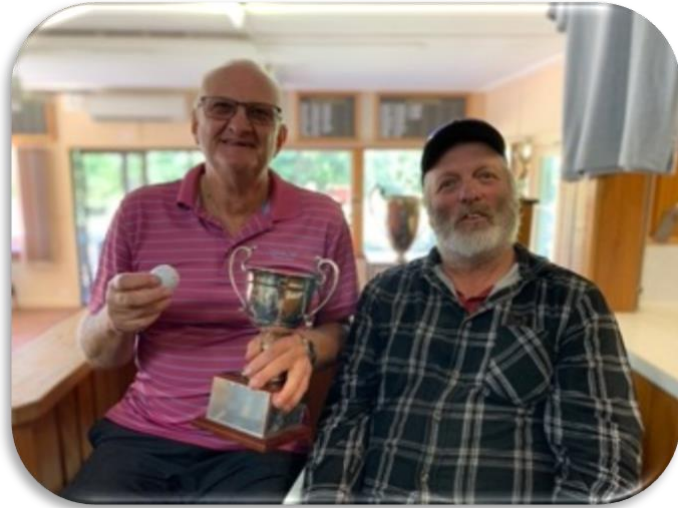

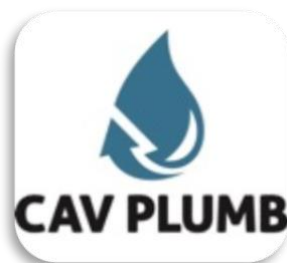

CLUB SHIRTS



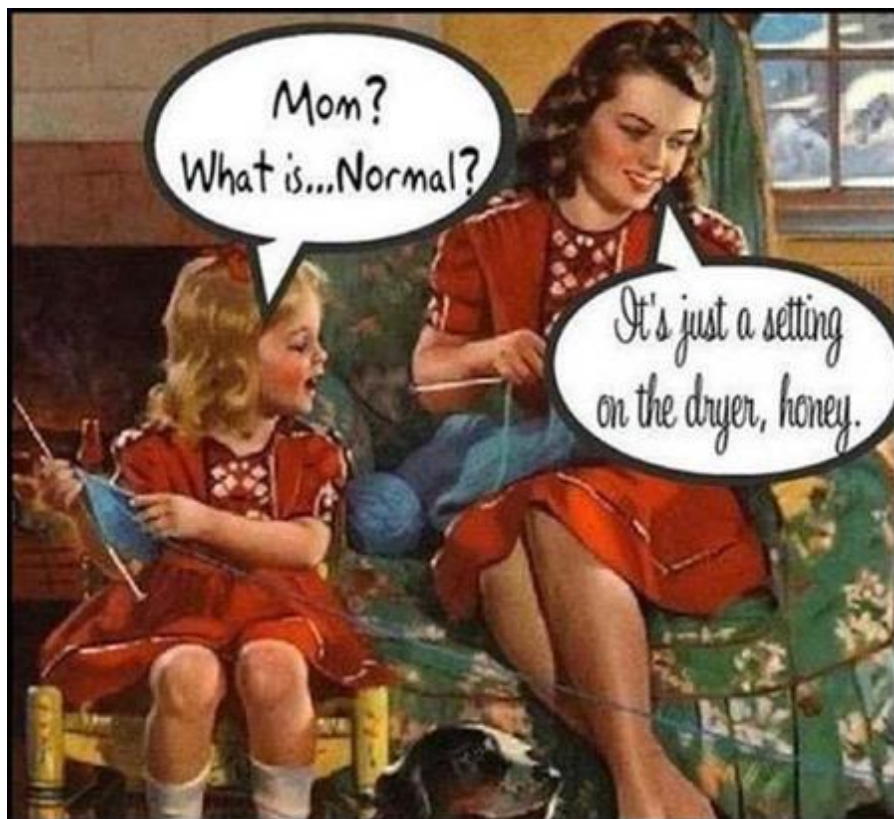

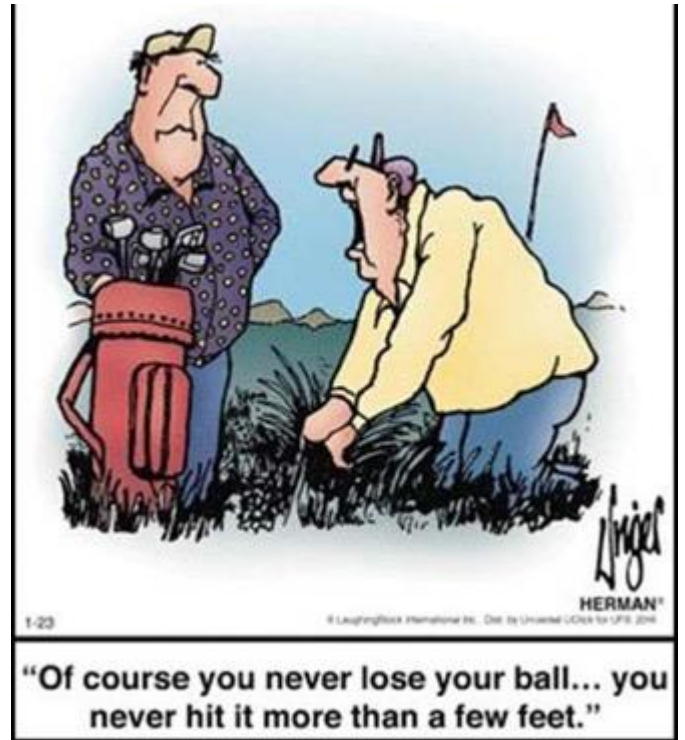
Our price is \$75 for members and \$85 for non-members.

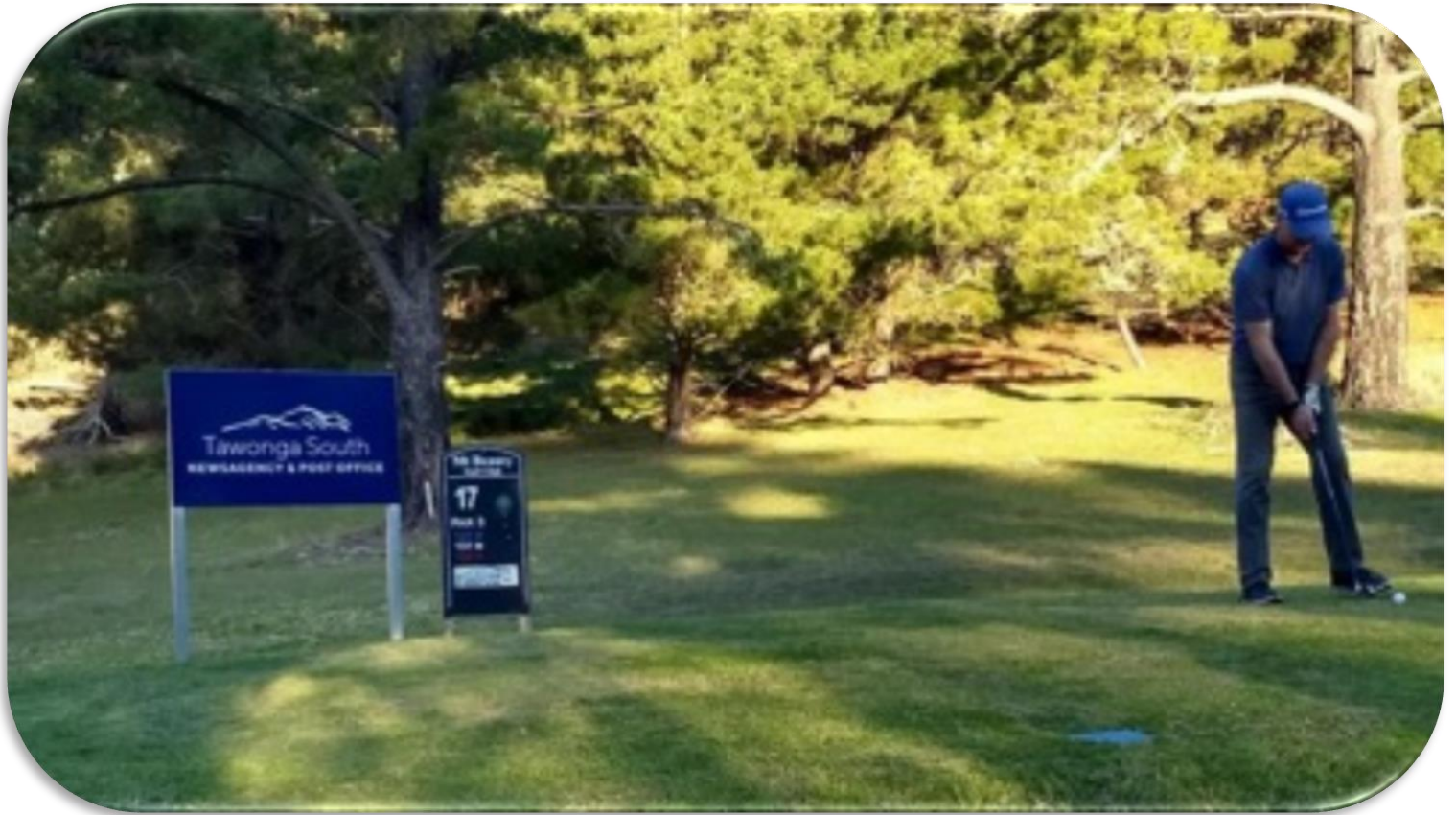
