Alf Mc Bain was an early member of the Mt Beauty Golf Club, with success in the 1957 Jarman Cup, the 1957 and 1960 Raynor Cups, and the 1963 Kiewa Hydro Cooperative Cup.

In 1964 the first "Alf Mc Bain Memorial" PAR event was won by Reinhart Beier. It has been by Stan Church in 1986 but not again until 2002. The 2023 Memorial went down to a 10 player play-off, with three times back to the 18<sup>th</sup> before darkness and hypothermia set in, and Keith Archibald remained triumphant.

Today's winner of the Alf McBain Memorial, after an eleven player playoff with a score of -1 is **KEITH ARCHIBALD**.

He was in driving force in transforming the Course from sand-scrapes to grass greens. Steve Green was awarded a Life Membership of the Club. On his passing, his ashes were scattered over the 9th Green.

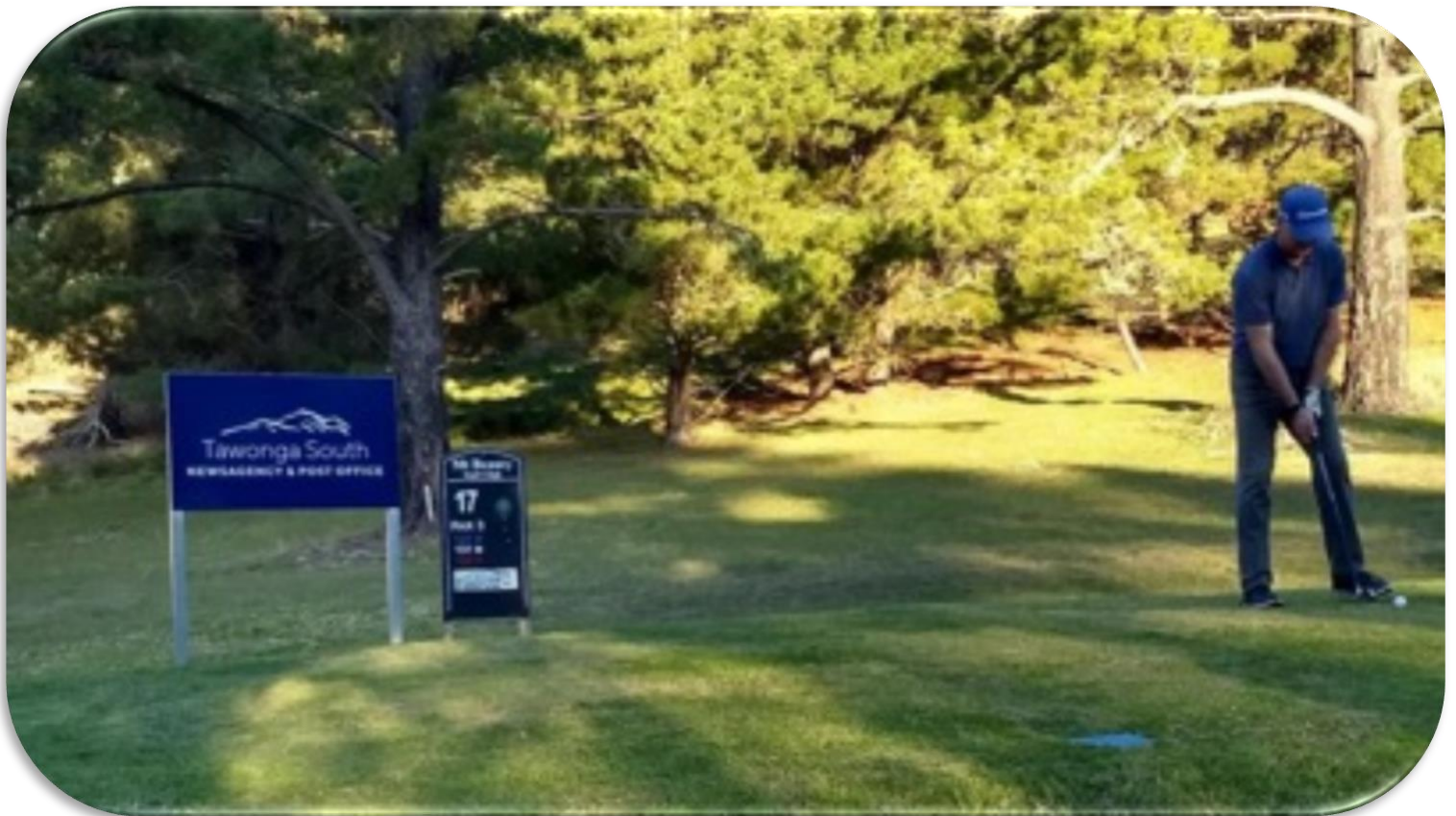
