COURSE NEWS

We have purchased a Blower to help keep the course cleaner & mainly to reduce the time & man power needed to verti-cut &/or core the greens.

Demand for our Hire Carts has been very good over the last 12 months – enough that 1 cart has been 'paid for'. They are averaging \$16 per cart per day to us, which is about 2 hours and 20 minutes of rental per cart per day for the whole year.

The Committee would like to remind all Cart Users that **NO CARTS are to be driven closer than 10 metres to ANY green**. Please be mindful of any wetter areas on the course & try to avoid driving through them.

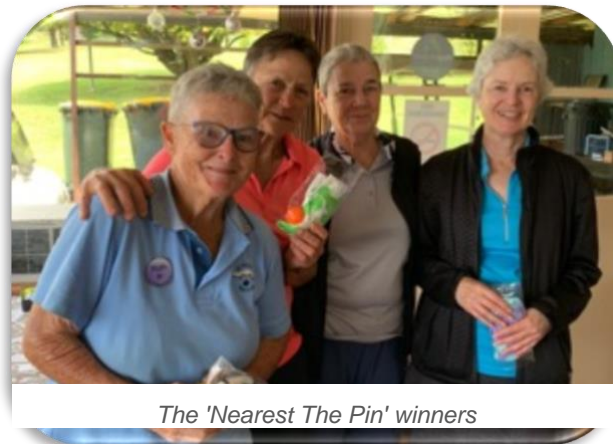

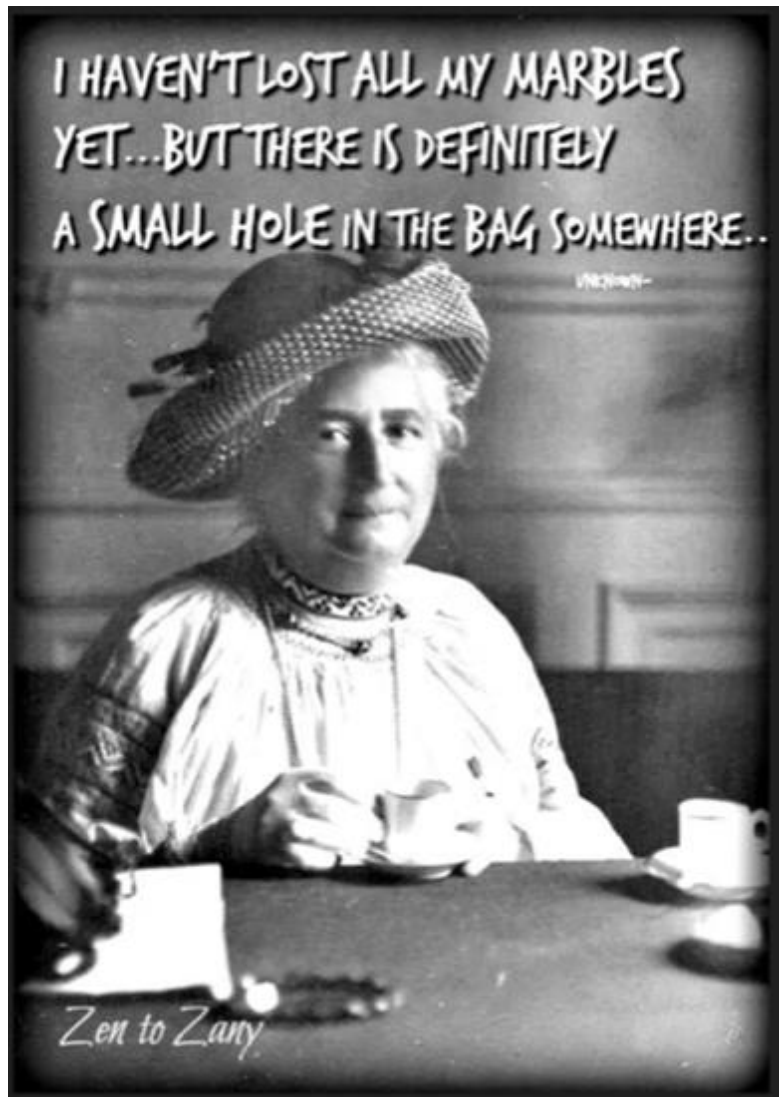

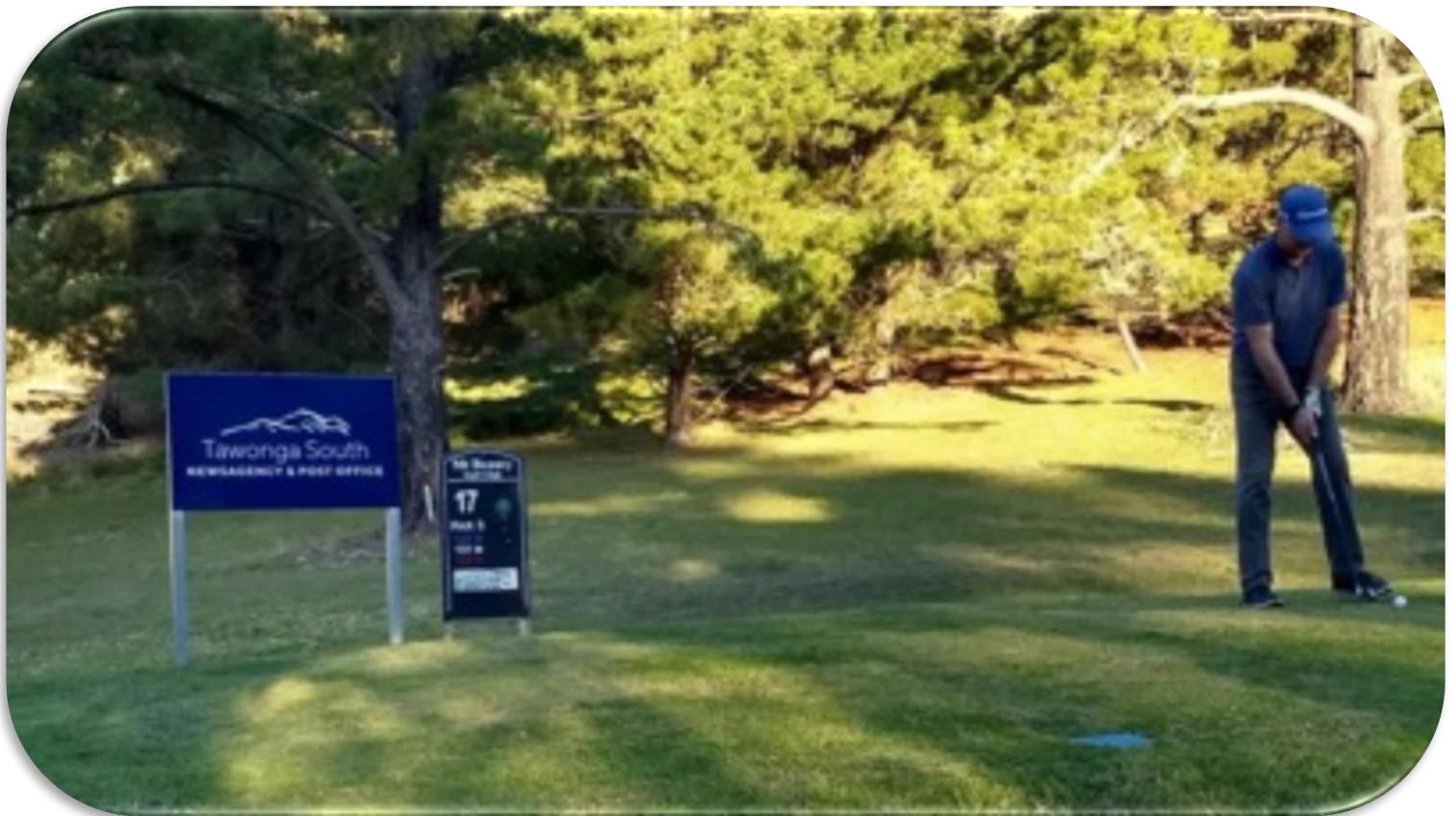
